



Table Grapes MOSCATEL ROMANO

Also known as Muscat of Malaga, Muscat of Alexandria and Muscat A Gros Grains, among other names.

Widely grown in Spain, both in irrigated and drought areas. Low vigour; requires short pruning.

Maturation can start around mid-July to mid-September.

Large, loose, winged and cylindrical-conic cluster.

Golden yellow, thick, elliptical berries with an intense Muscat taste and aroma. Crunchy, fleshy and weakly attached to the peduncle.

Reasonably resistant to transport. A table grape that can be used also to produce raisins and sweet wines.
